Caring For Your Inlay Wood Jewellery



The Titanium body of your ring, as well as protection from a clear lacquer on the hardwood, will protect your ring to a certain degree from water splashes. However, swimming or bathing with your ring on is not recommended.

The wood inlays are by no means as durable as a metal ring, but with care, it can last a lifetime. We strongly recommend use of a protective wax to further protect your ring. Should your ring get scratched or knocked, the wax will reseal it. To keep it in tip top condition, water must not penetrate the wood inlay.

In the event your wood inlay does become seriously damaged by water, harsh chemicals or rough treatment, we can replace your inlay for you at a fraction of the cost of a new ring.

Maintaining the finish of the wood regularly is integral to keeping the ring in excellent condition and preserving the wood.

We recommend Renaissance Wax for regular maintenance of the wood inlay.



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
